EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

QA engineer with 6 months at The Stackly, moving into product management. I own testing for a core module of a live web product, where my job is to turn expected behaviour into test cases and acceptance criteria, check the live product against the design and the API, and rank problems by user impact so the right fix ships first. Training in product management at Airtribe, where my Airbnb India case study scored **4.1/5** and was selected as a top submission. I bring a way of working that carries to any product team: clear requirements, gaps caught before release, and "done" that really means done for users.

- **Validated the live product against the Figma design and the backend API (Swagger)**, catching screens where the same data showed up differently.
- Agreed **expected behaviour and acceptance criteria** with developers before a fix was marked done, then retested until it held.
- Prepared bug reports in MS Word and defect trackers in MS Excel that **rank issues by severity and impact**, so the team knew what to fix first.
- Worked on a shared live environment with care, without changing data that other people depend on.
